No student will be allowed for admission into 1st Semester who passed HS Examination in or before 2021 as per UG regulation of the University.

(1) APPLICATION THROUGH ONLINE SYSTEM :

All the candidates will have to apply through Online (College Website : www.mahishadalrajcollege.com) for admission to the 4-Year B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com./ Industrial Chemistry/ B.C.A (Hons./Hons. with Research) and Multidisciplinary Programme for the academic session 2025 -2026

(2) ADMISSION AND PAYMENT THROUGH E-COUNSELLING AND ONLINE SYSTEM :

After Publishing of Final Merit List, the Phase wise E-COUNSELLING LIST will be published as per the Admission Notice. The Selected candidates will have to scan original copies of M.P. Admit, H.S. Admit, H.S. Marksheet, Caste Certificate, PH Certificate, EWS Certificate etc. and upload it to the portal (Max size : 100 kb and in jpg format) and pay the Admission Fees within the stipulated date(s) positively. All the Admission will be done through E-Counselling and Admission Fees have to pay through online process (using Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking). Candidates are advised to follow the Admission/E-counselling Notice in regular basis.

They are also advised to check the Admission Payment Status and if any discrepancies arise in this regard they will have to contact with the college office within the admission date positively. No objection will be entertained after the admission date.

In addition, they will have to study any 02 Subjects [maximum 01 Subject from one group of A B C D E F, as per Minor-1 and Minor-2 table, mentioned below (except the Single Major Subject)] as Minor-1 and Minor-2 alternatively in different Eight semesters, 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2nd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses (based on Single Major-Hons. In addition, they will have to study 02 AEC Courses in different Two semesters (English Communication in 1st & 3rd Sem. and Bengali/Hindi Communication in 2nd Sem. & 4th Sem.), 03 SEC Courses [SEC-1 is based on Major-1 (A), SEC-2 is based on Major-2 (B), SEC-3 is based on Minor (C)] in different Three semesters, 03 Multidisciplinary Subjects (as per Multidisciplinary Course/Subject table*, mentioned below) in different Three semesters, 02 Value Added Courses (ENVS in 1st Sem. & Human Rights/Yoga and Wellness/Disaster Mgmt. in 2nd Sem.), participate in 02 Summer Internship Courses different Two semesters (one in 2nd Sem., other in 4th Sem.) during Three years.
